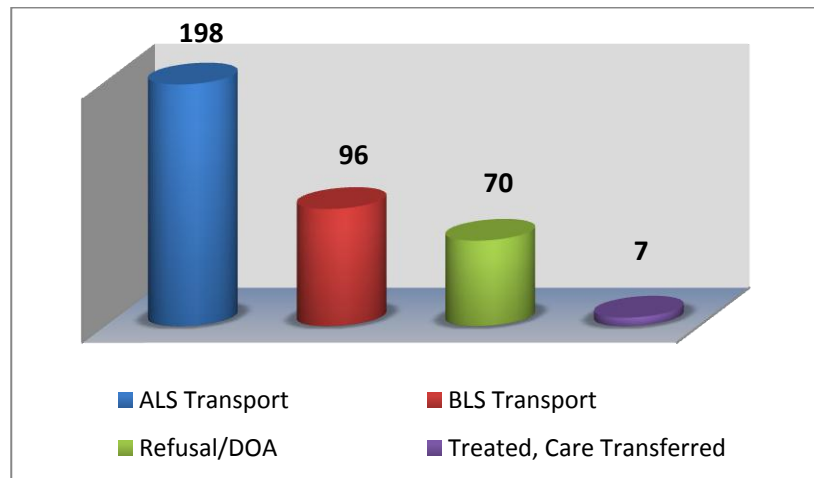

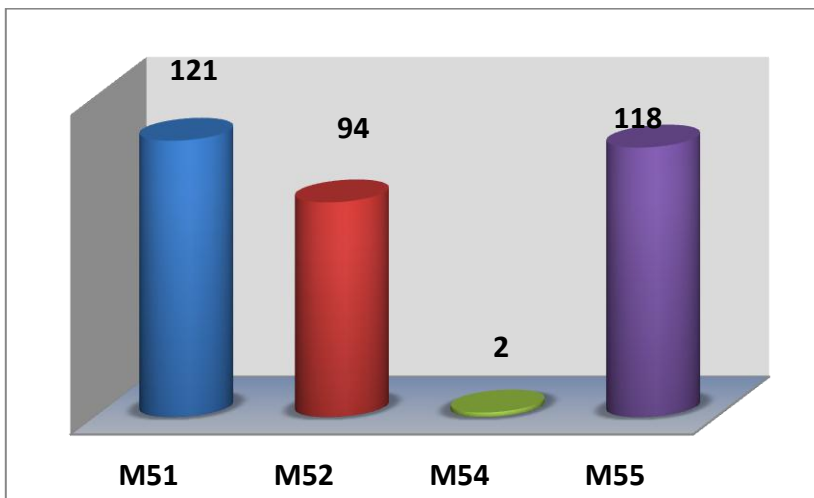
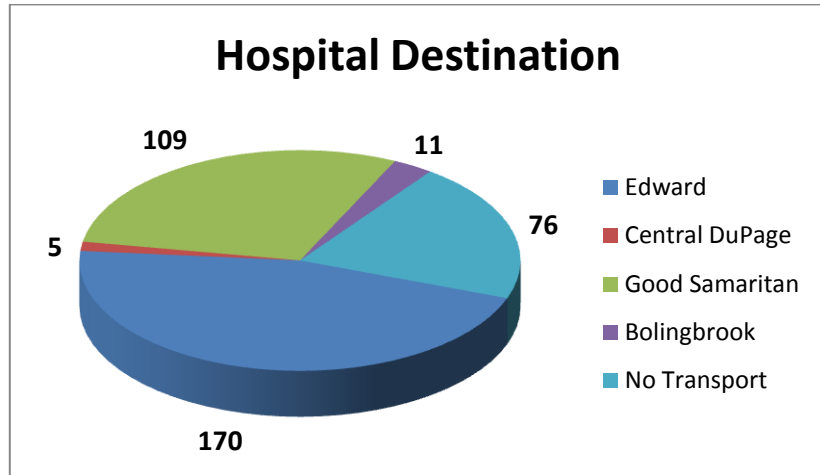


Top 5 Incident Types

Fall /Back Injury	55
Traffic Accidents	48
Sick Person	45
Psychiatric/Suicide Attempt	38
Unconscious/Fainting	23



Patients have the option to be transported to any of the four hospitals. Edward Hospital was our primary transport hospital with 170 transports.



M51 documented more calls once again this month compared to M52 and M55. M54 documented 2 calls while covering hire back events. These reports include Transport and Refusal/DOA.

Our Non-Transport ALS vehicles documented a total of 36 EMS calls. These calls were for Refusals, DOA's, Treated and Care Transferred.
