## *Points of Interest*

NFPA 13 requires wet pipe sprinkler systems to be maintained at or above 40 degrees Fahrenheit at all times. If this is not possible the system must be made into a dry pipe system. In warm climates (right) where the air temperature never gets this cold the system risers, control valves, and FDC piping is often all located outside of the building so emergency responders have quick access to the systems.
