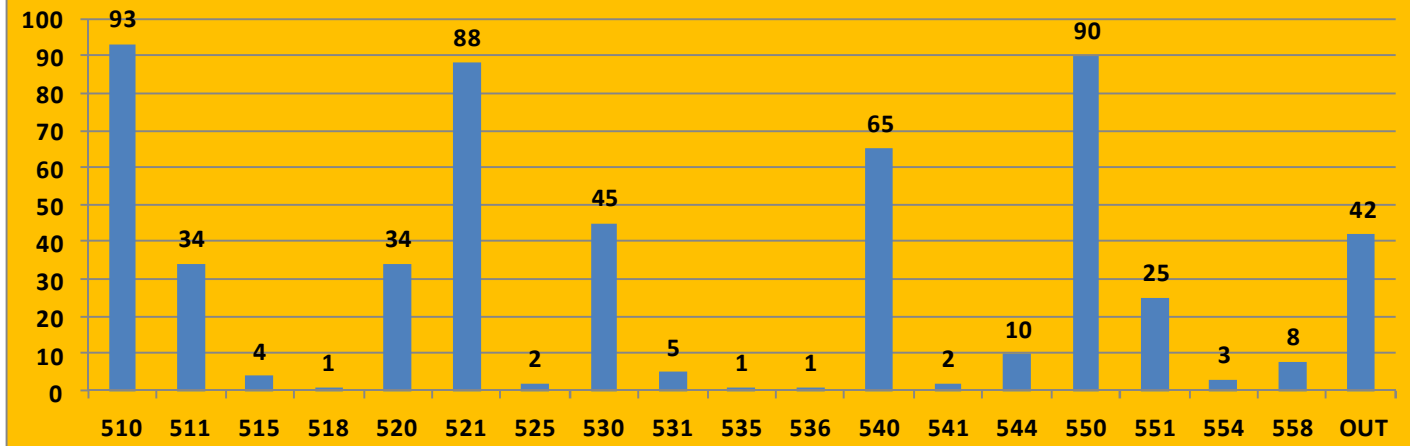

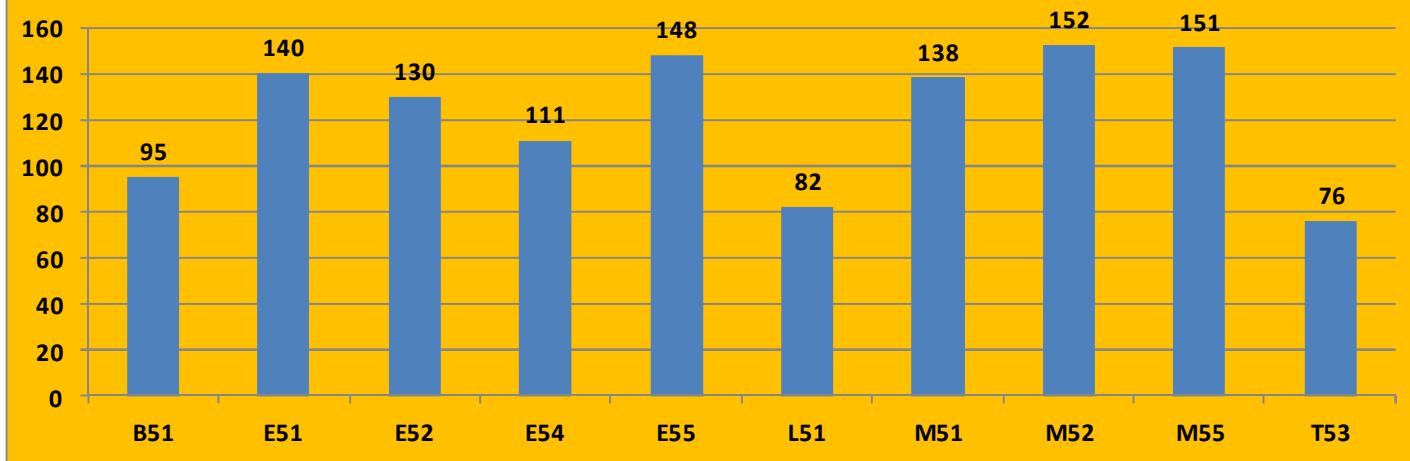

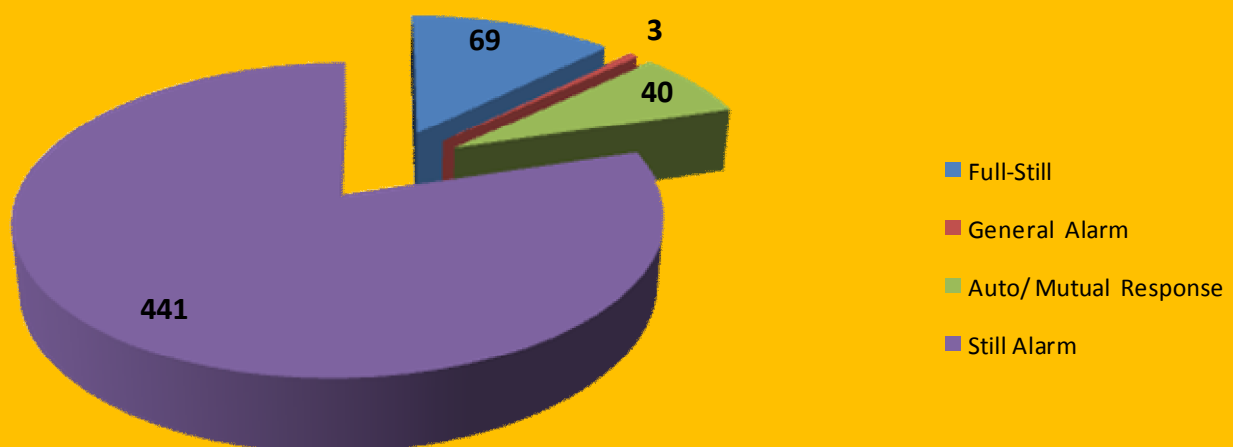
INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT
