Surface Ice Rescue

The Surface Ice Rescue training prepares first first-in companies to respond and carry out surface ice tasks performed by rescues. This training introduces company members to topics including ice formation and hazards, equipment selection, emergency communications, medical considerations, and the application of our proven rescue methods and techniques. This is a surface rescue program and does not involve diving.

❖ Harassment Training

This is an annual mandated training topic that is completed by all members of the Fire District and along with the Board of Trustees and Board of Fire Commissioners. Workplace harassment is a violation of title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Harassment is an act committed by a person that makes another feel uncomfortable, offended, intimidated or oppressed. In order for it to be workplace harassment, it should happen in an environment like an office, a store, a school, a factory or any place where people are employed and conduct work.
