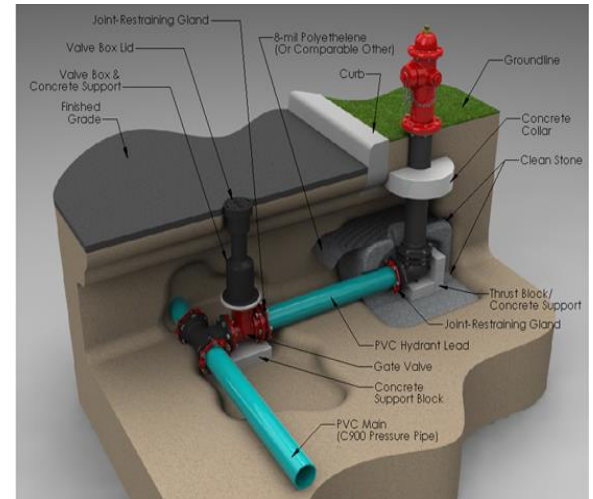

Hydrant Operations/Flow Testing

As the majority of our Fire District is supplied by fire hydrants the operations, hydrant hook-up, and supply capabilities is crucial. Companies were trained and evaluated on operations and hook-up objectives to supply all front fire suppression vehicles.



Defensive hoseline operations

Defensive operations are exterior fire suppression operations directed at protecting exposures from the communication of heat/fire via direct fire contact or conduction, convection or radiation. This is accomplished by the coordinated efforts of multiple hose lines, appliances and apparatus.

Trench Rescue Operations

Trench rescue operations are the focus of safe and quick technical rescue support from our MABAS and CART team's personnel and equipment. The fundamental focus of this training was on equipment familiarization and coordinated team efforts to the many assigned tasks.
