All Hazard Evacuation Drill Training

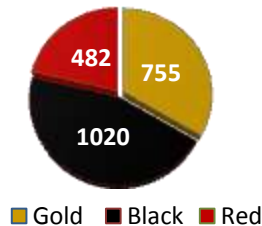

Annual Physicals - Part II

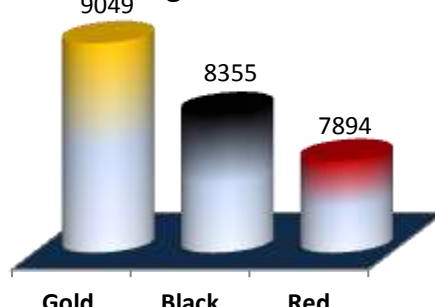
We continued the 2 part physicals required by NFPA for all fire service personnel. The physicals are conducted throughout the month and to conclude in November.
