**SAFETY FIRST!**

**Safety First!**  
Officers control your crew members, look out for them

Wear required PPE

- Helmet
- Hood
- Structural Firefighting Gloves
- Coat
- Pants

Wear your SCBA

Use your feetight

**Safety First!**  
Only 2 hand lines in a stairwell  
Hand lines shall be against the wall for clearance to walk  
Work in pairs  
Watch for tools

Wear your safety glasses while working

- Hand tools
- Power tools

During take-up/overhaul

**Safety First!**  
If you can't see your feet, get down  
Watch your step  
Use proper lifting techniques

Stay hydrated! Before, during and after evolutions

**Safety First!**  
Listen to your radio  
Call for help if needed  
Watch for slippery surfaces  
3 Points of contact when on ladders at all times

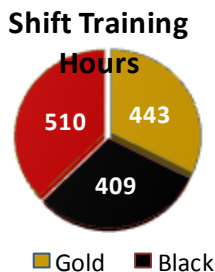
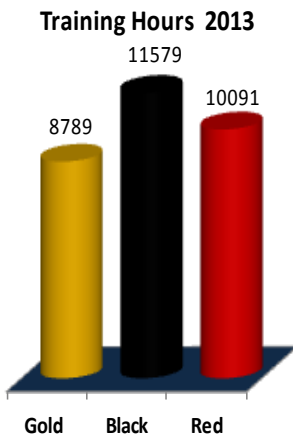

### Fire Drills & Public Education

Throughout the month of October the fire companies assisted the Fire Prevention Bureau with all the school fire drills. The efforts of the joint Division training provided the schools with information on efficient and effective fire drills emphasizing the importance of accountability of both the students, teachers administrators and administrative support staff. This also provided the fire companies to pre-plan the schools and review the alarm systems in each of the schools in Lisle and Woodridge.

### Acquired Structure Training
