Monthly Summary

The Lisle-Woodridge Fire District responded to 609 incidents this month. Total incidents year to date is 6,764; this is 531 incidents ahead of last year. 416 (68%) of the monthly total were requests for Emergency Services and the remaining 193 (32%) were Fire/Rescue related.

We responded Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 74 times and received Mutual Aid/Auto Aid 57 times.

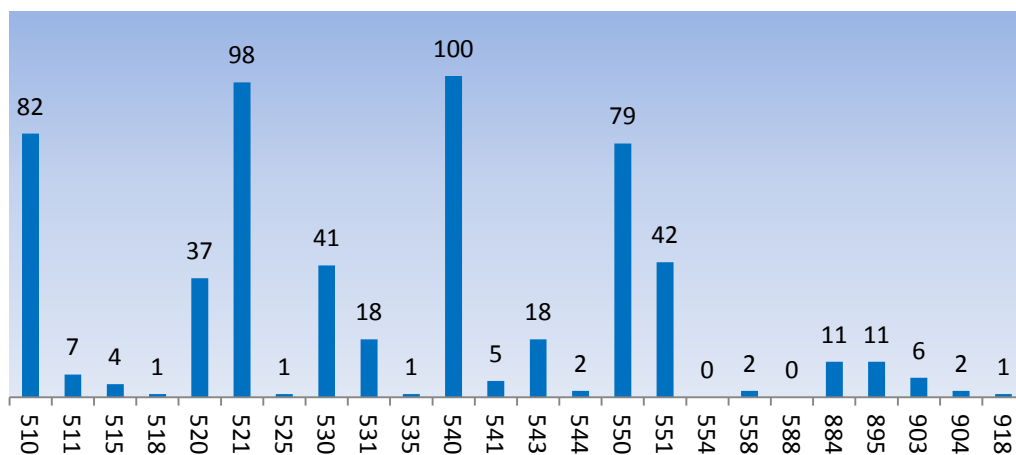
